Step 4: Add _____ oz. **Leisure Time Enzyme**, removes oil, lotion, and organics from spa water. (1oz. per 250 gallons)

Renew/Reserve Weekly Maintenance

Step 2: Add _____ oz. **Leisure Time Reserve**, mix of bromide salts that becomes a powerful bromine sanitizer when combined with Renew. (4oz. per 250 gallons)

Step 3: Add _____ oz. **Leisure Time Renew**, non-chlorine shock oxidizer will create a bromine residual and shock-oxidize the water. (4oz. per 250 gallons)

Step 4: Add _____ oz. **Leisure Time Defender**, prevents scale forming on surfaces. (2oz. per 800 gallons, 4oz. over 800 gallons)

Step 5: Add _____ oz. **Leisure Time Enzyme**, removes oils, lotion, and organics from spa water. (1oz. per 250 gallons)
